

Beef Checkoff Remittance for Local Beef Sales



For every head of cattle you sell, by law, \$1 dollar is owed to the Beef Checkoff for promotion, research, and education programs that help keep beef at the center of consumers breakfast, lunch and dinner plates. Did you know the Checkoff Dollar is also due when you custom harvest your cattle and sell the beef? Even those dollars fund initiatives like the iconic *Beef. It's What's for Dinner.* campaigns, sustainability and beef safety research, nutrition messaging, and much more

If you sold beef this year, and have not paid the Checkoff dollar, you can fill out the form below and remit with payment to the **New York Beef Council, C/O NBT Bank, 1148 Erie Blvd. West, Rome, NY 13440.** If remitting for the whole year, use the month remitted as the date harvested.

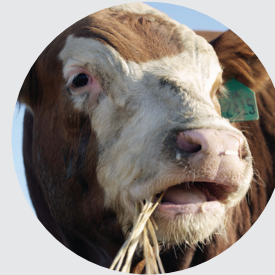

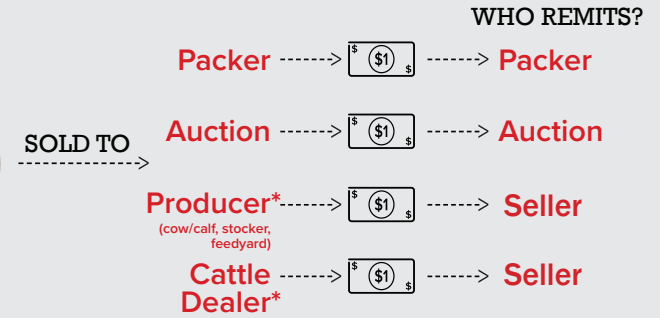

Understanding Who Remits Beef Checkoff Dollars



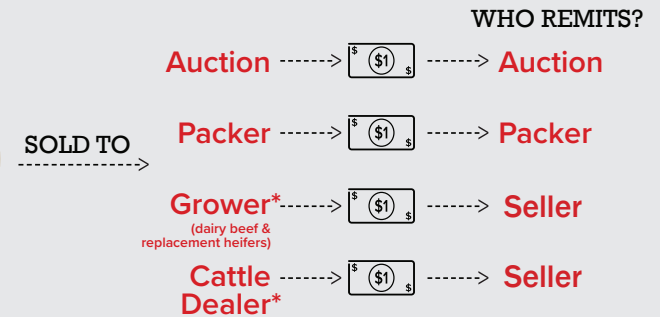
BEEF PRODUCER



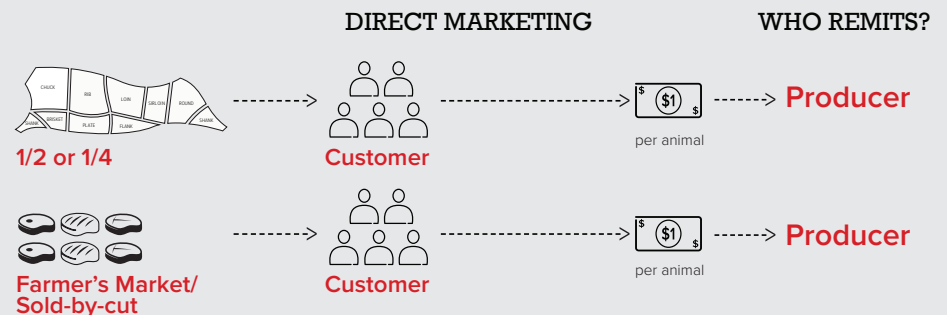
ANY BOVINE SOLD → \$1 → MUST BE REMITTED

* For private treaty sales, both the Buyer and the Seller are responsible for remittance.



* According to the Beef Promotion and Research Act of 1985 either the seller or buyer can remit the beef checkoff, however for clarity and consistency we encourage the seller to take on that compliance responsibility.
